1.	NEW EDUBIASE FC	New Edubiase FC was charged for breaching Article 33(1)(b) of the GFA Disciplinary Code, 2019. According to the Charge sheet, on or about the 57th minute of the match between New Edubiase FC and Bekwai Youth Football Academy (BYFA) at the Nana Gyamfi Park, the club president, officials, players and supporters did chase and assaulted match officials, actions that caused for the abrupt end of the match.	In its defence, New Edubiase FC stated that at no point in the match did the President of the Club Abdul Salam Yakubu chase any Match Official. The Club added that its President who was rather jubilating towards the technical bench of his team when his team scored only to realize later that the goal had been disallowed. It was added that some fans rushed into the inner perimeter to protect the Referee after he disallowed the goal.	Per evidence adduced from the Referee's report and the video recording of the match, New Edubiase FC is found Guilty of the charge by the Committee. The Committee hereby makes the following decisions: 1. Fined Three Thousand Ghana Cedis (GHc3,000) 2. New Edubiase FC, its Officials and the club supporters are warned that any future misconduct shall receive a more severe punishment.

 ABDUL SALAM YAKUBU – PRESIDENT (NEW EDUBIASE FC) Abdul Salam Yakubu was charged for breaching Article 12(1)(i) and Article 12(1)(j) of the GFA Disciplinary Code,2019. Per the Charge sheet, on or about the 57th minute of the match between New Edubiase FC and Bekwai Youth Football Academy, at the Nana Gyamfi Park, you did chase after assistant referee 2 (Kwame Frimpong) in an attempt to physically attack him, an act that amounts to unsporting behavior towards a match official. 	Abdul Salam Yakubu in his defense denied chasing the referee. The Club President stated that he was rather jubilating towards the technical bench of his team when his team scored, only to realize later that the goal had been disallowed.	Per evidence adduced from the Referee's report and the video recording of the match, Abdul Salam Yakubu is found Guilty of the charge by the Committee. The Committee found that the behaviour of the President incited the players and other members of the team to do same. The Committee hereby makes the following decisions: 1. That for his position as a club President and to have misconducted himself in this manner, a fined Two Thousand Ghana Cedis (GHc2,000). 2. Two (2) matches ban is hereby imposed on him. 3. Abdul Salam is warned that any future misconduct shall receive a more severe punishment.

The Committee hereby makes the following decisions: 1. Fined One Thousand Ghana Cedis (GHc1000). 2. Two (2) matches ban is hereby imposed on him.

On or about the 57th minute of the match between New Edubiase and Bekwai Youth Football Academy, at the Nana Gyamfi Park, did verbally attack center referee (Samuel Yeboah) by stating among others that, if he doesn't restart the match, the worst will happen to him, an act that amounts to unsporting behavior towards a match official.
